On June 26, 2008, Shell Oil Products US (Shell) received your letter dated June 13, 2008 regarding the notification requirements under Part 1600 of the Illinois Administrative Code. Although at this point Shell does not agree that current information would indicate the necessary prerequisites for potential vapor intrusion have been evidenced in this matter, Shell will provide the community notification requirements as required under Part 1600.

As discussed in our telephone conversation on June 26, 2008, Shell is requesting a meeting in Springfield and would suggest July 16, 2008 to discuss the community relations requirements of Part 1600 as they apply to this matter. It is our understanding that the 30-day clock for submittal of a Community Relations Plan will begin after that meeting.
