The Steam Enhanced Extraction (SEE) System at the Roxana former Public Works Yard (FPWY) began its 2025 operations in March, and continued operation throughout the year. The injection of steam into the subsurface at the FPWY was permanently shut down on the afternoon of November 22, 2025. Vapor extraction in the FPWY area will continue for a minimum of 30 days after the end of steam injection.
