Class 1* Permit Modification – Further Discussion of W-85 Notification Timeline; W-85 Removal; Proposal for New Well (W-92)

AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM), on behalf of Equilon Enterprises LLC d/b/a Shell Oil Products US (Shell), is submitting this Class 1* Permit Modification in accordance with Condition IV(K)(2) of Shell's RCRA Post-Closure Permit, issued September 23, 2010, and most recently modified October 31, 2022.

Further Discussion on W-85 Notification Timeline

Water production well W-85 was taken offline on March 9, 2023, for routine cleaning and maintenance. After the well shutdown, a precleaning inspection was performed by Phillips 66 personnel/well drilling subcontractor (crews). This inspection led to the discovery of sand having accumulated within the well pipe. This has been seen at other water production wells before and is typically managed by removal of the accumulated sediment followed by sleeving the well (installing a slightly smaller diameter casing within the existing well casing to seal off and prevent sediment from accumulating again) and performing a downhole camera inspection. Phillips 66 crews attempted to remove the accumulated sand on March 15, 2023, at which time a sinkhole opened immediately next to the W-85 well pipe at the surface. A worker fell and was injured when the sinkhole opened; therefore, a "stop-work" was issued. Several discussions and evaluations took place to address the following items:

- Investigate the incident that occurred.
- How to fill in the sinkhole and stabilize the ground.
- How to perform the sediment removal, sleeving and camera inspection of W-85 safely.

On June 1, 2023, Shell was notified by Phillips 66 that the ground had successfully been stabilized and the sediment removal, sleeving and camera inspection were ready to be completed. Sleeving was successfully completed on June 8, 2023, and the downhole camera inspection was performed on June 12, 2023. On June 19, 2023, the video from the camera inspection was shared by Phillips 66 with Shell and AECOM. This video showed that the screen of W-85 was cracked and out of round in several places.

It was during a meeting on June 19, 2023, that Shell and Phillips 66 determined that water production well W-85 was damaged and that a repair was not likely to be successful, as was originally planned. With this determination being made, Shell and Phillips 66 considered June 19, 2023, to be the date that initiated the 30-day notification requirement in Condition IV(D)(4) of the Permit. The *Notice of Water Production Well W-85 Damage* was submitted to IEPA on July 6, 2023.



Removal of Water Production Well W-85 from the Permit

This modification is requesting removal of water production well W-85, designated in the Permit for gradient control, as it is no longer able to serve its intended purpose. A notification of the condition of well W-85 was submitted to Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) on July 6, 2023. This water production well was plugged and abandon on July 21, 2023, due to the compromised integrity of the screen of this well. Enclosed is a copy of the Water Well Sealing Form associated with water production well W-85.

New Water Production Well Proposal

A location for installation of a replacement water production well has been selected and is roughly due east of the original W-85 water production well location (see image below). This is the closest physical location that was deemed safe due to the vicinity of overhead power lines and other surficial features in conjunction with subsurface infrastructure. Water Well W-85 was located immediately west of the berm surrounding a tank yard. The new well location selected is approximately 60 feet to the east of W-85, on the other side of the berm surrounding the neighboring tank yard. The image below is a snapshot from some preliminary modeling work and depicts the groundwater contours modeled with the removal of W-85 and assuming the new well location with construction and pumping similar to that of W-85.



Coordination with the drilling subcontractor is currently in progress, and the replacement water production well (W-92) will be installed in general accordance with the requirements of the Permit and similar to Water Production Well W-85. In accordance with Condition IV(D)(6) of the Permit, the boring log and water well construction report for the replacement water production well will be submitted as a Class 1* Permit Modification Request once installation is completed.



The cost estimate for a replacement water production well is summarized below:
