Subject: Roxana SVE System Shutdown - Notification

Gary:

The purpose of this correspondence is to provide the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“IEPA”) an update on the shutdown of the Roxana soil vapor extraction (“SVE”) system and to notify the IEPA that the SVE system has been returned to service.

On , March 12, 2026, AECOM provided notification of shutdown of the SVE system for an electrical component replacement. Item 7 of IEPA’s April 9, 2014 letter (Log No. B-43R-CA-65, 68, and 76) and Item 7 of IEPA’s May 15, 2015 letter (Log No. B-43R-CA-66 and 84) requires that the IEPA Bureau of Land, Permit Section, and the Collinsville Field Office be notified by e-mail if the SVE system is down for more than 72 continuous hours.

The electrical component was replaced, and its operation tested. With the repairs completed, the SVE system was returned to service at 11:16 am on March 13, 2026.
