SHELL CONTRACTORS TO PERFORM TESTING TO ENHANCE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP SYSTEM

You may recall that Shell recently demolished and removed three houses at the intersection of Chaffer and Fourth Streets to allow the potential expansion of its remediation efforts in the area near the western fenceline of the WRB Refining LP Wood River refinery.

Shell has already planted grass on one of the properties and the other two properties will also have grass planted in the near future, weather permitting. An existing garage remains for possible use for the remedial work.

Shell continues to work closely with the Illinois EPA on the next steps to move the remediation forward.

As part of this effort, a Shell contractor will conduct additional drilling and testing on the three properties. The work is expected to occur in early May and take about a week to complete. During this time, you may see several workers and testing equipment on the properties.
