

CONSTRUCTION OF REMEDIATION SYSTEM IN **ROXANA. ILLINOIS TO BEGIN**

WHO: Shell Oil Products US

WHAT:

URS and other contractors, on behalf of Shell Oil Products US have been working in the area near Chaffer Street between First Street and the Roxana Public Works Yard. The work, performed under the oversight of Illinois EPA, is to construct a soil vapor extraction system inside the Wood River Refinery, to remove hydrocarbon vapors from

the subsurface.


There will be construction equipment in the area as part of this work, e.g., dump trucks, cranes, concrete trucks, drilling equipment, etc. During the work, the contractors will maintain awareness of the noise levels and if necessary, noise reduction measures will be implemented. such as the use of temporary sound walls.

Also, whenever possible the use of motorized equipment will be limited to between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm. Extended closures street are not anticipated. Shell and its contractors will work to minimize the impacts that could arise from the construction activities and apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you.

WHEN:

Starting October 17, 2011. The is expected to work take approximately 3 months. The work is planned to occur during the day, Monday through Friday.

WHERE: The primary work is being conducted inside the Wood River Refinery and on the Roxana Public Works Yard (blue hatched area shown on map).
