As a follow-up to our telephone conversation today, and on behalf of Shell Oil Products US, I am requesting that the Agency grant SOPUS the ability to optimize the product recovery system in well P-60.

As described in SOPUS' response to IEPA's November 25, 2008 letter (dated January 21, 2009), the pumping system in well P-60 was installed as an interim application. The system is currently being field-tested, which involves adjusting the cycle time and frequency in order to maximize product recovery. Approving this request will allow us to continue work to improve the efficiency of this system.
