Dear Mr. Dyer:

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") **REJECTS** the June 10, 2011 Compliance Commitment Agreement ("CCA") submitted by Shell Oil Products U.S. which was received by the Illinois EPA on June 13, 2011 in response to the April 19, 2011 Violation Notice.

The CCA is rejected due to the nature and seriousness of the violations. Please be advised that resolution of the violations may require the involvement of a prosecutorial authority for purposes that may include, among others, the imposition of statutory penalties. This CCA is also rejected because it was late.

Because the violations remain the subject of disagreement between the Illinois EPA and Shell Oil Products U.S. this matter may be considered for referral to the Office of the Attorney General, the State's Attorney of Madison County or the United States Environmental Protection Agency for formal enforcement action and the imposition of penalties.
