The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") **REJECTS** the July 22, 2008 Compliance Commitment Agreement ("CCA") submitted by Shell Oil Products U.S. which was received by the Illinois EPA on June 22, 2008 in response to the May 2, 2008 Violation Notice.

The CCA is rejected due to the nature and seriousness of the violations. Please be advised that resolution of the violation may require the involvement of a prosecutorial authority for purposes that may include, among others, the imposition of statutory penalties.


Because the violations remain the subject of disagreement between the Illinois EPA and Shell Oil Products U.S. this matter may be considered for referral to the Office of the Attorney General, the State's Attorney of Madison County or the United States Environmental Protection Agency for formal enforcement action and the imposition of penalties.
