Dear Mr. Nightingale:

On behalf of Shell Oil Products US (SOPUS), URS Corporation (URS) is submitting this notification in response to Condition 3(c) of the Agency's letter dated May 12, 2009, which requires notification if "... free product is discovered by SOPUS outside of the WRR property boundaries...".

On January 31, 2011, 0.04 feet of light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL) was identified in piezometer ROST-4-PZ. This piezometer is located at the intersection of 3rd Street and Chaeffer Street. The piezometer was gauged again the morning of February 7th and no product was identified. The piezometer was re-gauged in the afternoon of February 7th, as confirmation of the morning result, and the instrument indicated 0.01 feet of product. The LNAPL was gauged via oilwater interface meter. ROST-4-PZ is a ¾ inch diameter piezometer, screened from a depth of approximately 38 to 48 feet below ground. The fluid levels measured are above the top of the screen, approximately 37 feet below ground.

Historically, groundwater analytical data from this area (e.g., GWP-4) did not indicate concentrations that would be indicative of product (e.g., benzene 0.258 mg/L at GWP-4). The product observation may be related to the recent loss of ground water control at the refinery although a definitive cause is unknown at this time. SOPUS intends to continue gauging this piezometer on a weekly basis, concurrent with the gauging being done to assess groundwater control.
